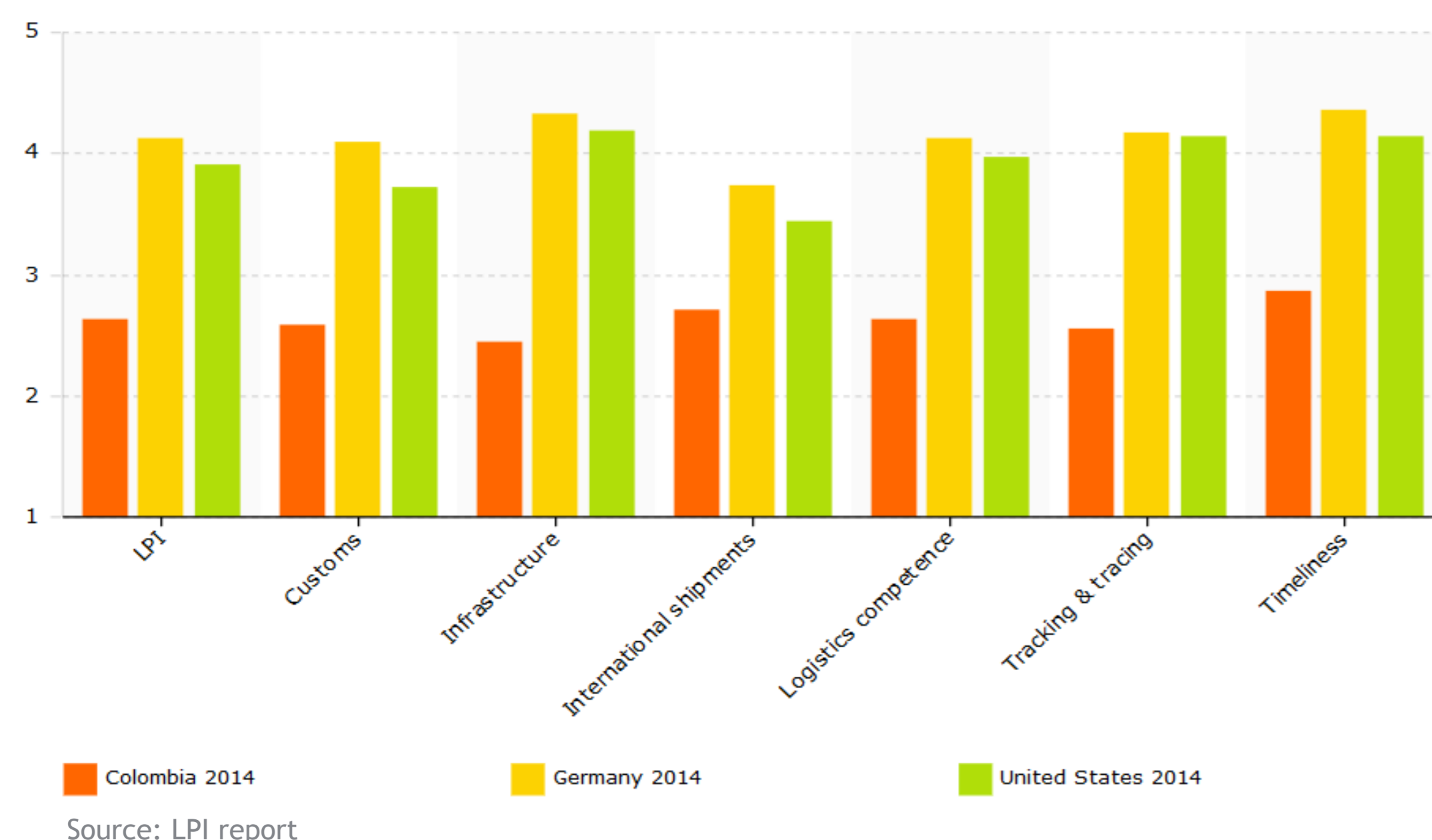


PRIVATE PUBLIC PARTNERSHIPS FOR LOGISTIC INFRASTRUCTURE IN COLOMBIA

Motivation / Background

- Colombia dropped 33 positions from 64th to 97th on the World Bank Logistics Performance Index LPI for the year 2014.
- Colombia is 126th out 140 studied countries in roads quality.
- Governments need to create models to promote infrastructure project development or administration via partnerships.

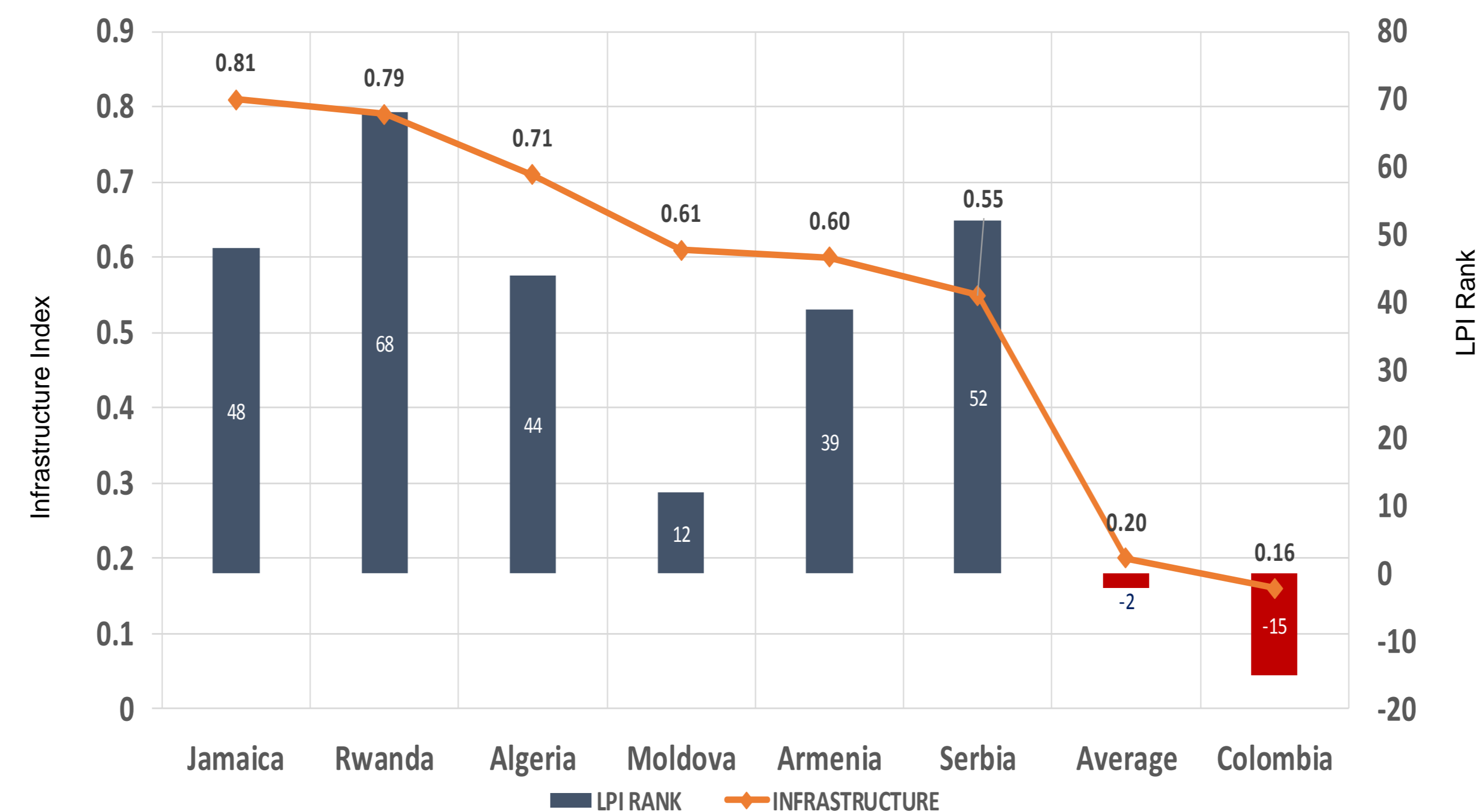


Key Question / Hypothesis

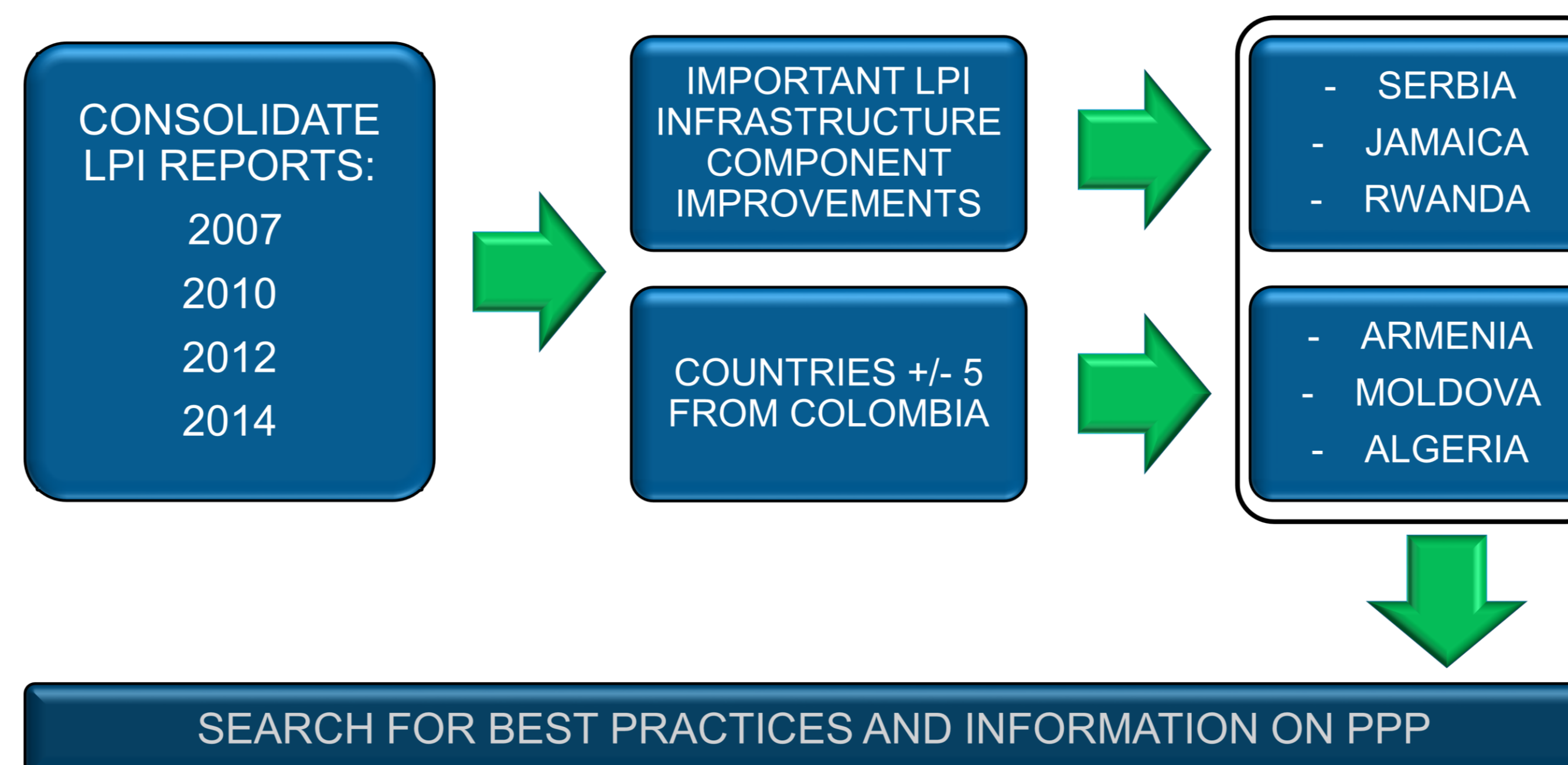
- Are the Private Public Partnerships a potential model of infrastructure development in Colombia?

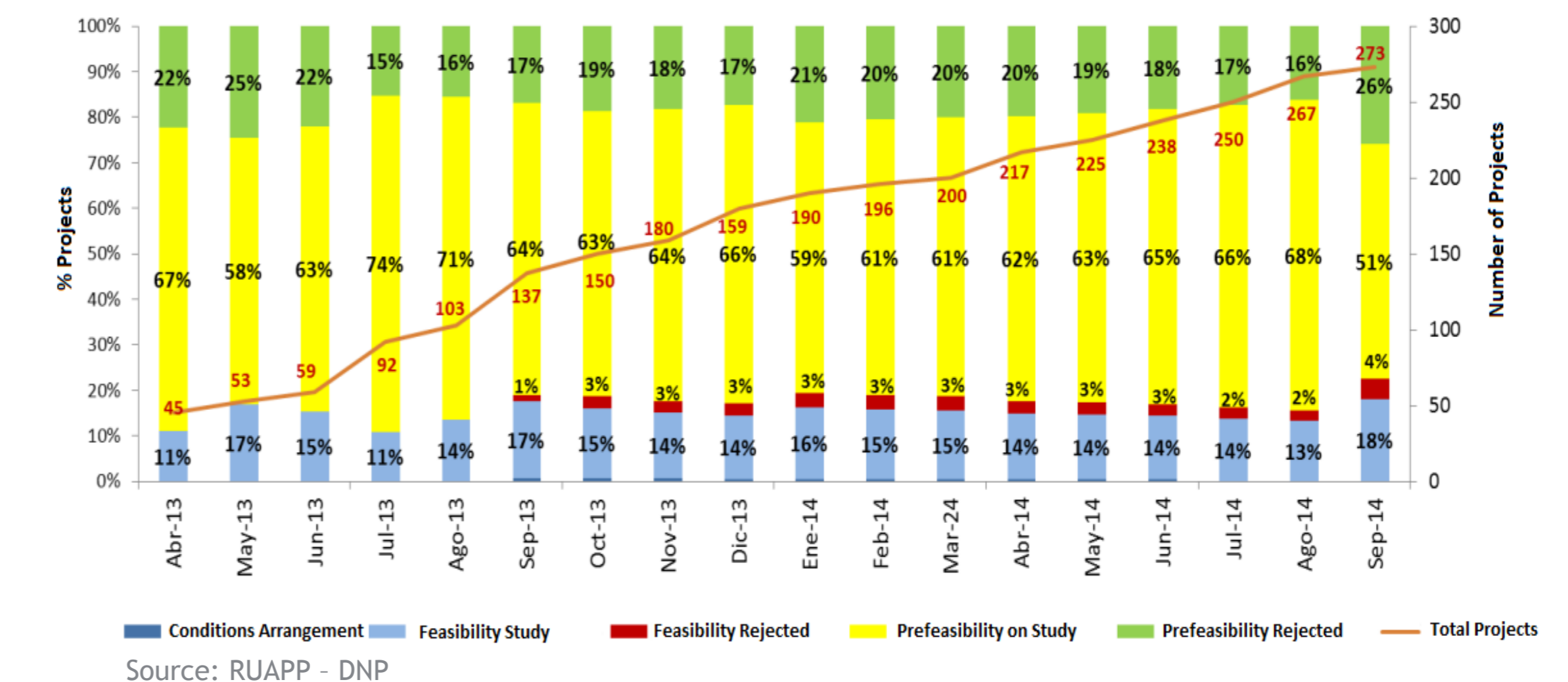


Methodology

Expected Contribution

- There is no evidence of a strong link between good practices of PPP and improvements on LPI infrastructure index and LPI ranking
- PPP projects can become an important driver for the improvement of the infrastructure of country, but are not the best nor the only way to do so
- It is needed to review the legal framework of the country, the strength of the institutions and the interconnection between them
- It is important to Countries should generate a constant combination of foreign and local funding for PPP projects and have a dedicated Agency of PPP's
